



**Memorandum of Understanding  
For Youth Exchange Project  
Between**



**Bangkok Metropolitan Council of Kingdom of Thailand  
And  
The Municipality of Stjordal of Kingdom of Norway**

The Bangkok Metropolitan Council of the Kingdom of Thailand and the Stjordal Municipality Council of the Kingdom of Norway signed Agreement on the Establishment of Sister City Council Relations on 6<sup>th</sup> May 2009 based on the principle of equity and mutual benefits. In light of friendly relations between the two city councils, both parties have approved the initiative on the cooperation of youth exchange project with the guidelines of practice as follow:

- Youth delegates shall be at least 15 years old and not more than 20 years old.
- Each party shall bear expenses incurred on reciprocal basis which would be agreed on each exchange occasion.
- Youth Exchange Delegation shall comprise 8 youths and 2 involving youth overseeing officials during the period of 8 consecutive nights in host country.
- Each host city will endeavor its utmost to create the fruitful program for the selected youths to experience the country and the city valuable culture, traditions and way of life in the protective and decent environment as well as other areas that will create good understanding among the youths as a foundation for further development of other related future projects.
- English shall be used as the most common way of interaction.

This Memorandum of Understanding is established in English language as the guidelines of practice concerning the youth exchange project and signed by both parties as evidence of content comprehension on January 13, 2012 in Stjordal of Kingdom of Norway.
