Friendship exchanges between the Stjordal Kommun and the BMC will be initiated and conducted by both sides to the promotion of their prosperity and the constant development of good relationship.

In line with the newly established friendship relations and the principles of equality and mutual benefit, the BMC and the Stjordal Kommun contemplate to carry out sister city council exchanges and cooperation by various means in different fields such as social, culture, education, tourism, health, environment, science and technology etc.

In order to be able to achieve the above mentioned goals, this agreement must firstly get approval of the council of the BMC and the municipality Stjordal Kommun and that both parties will consult with each other on any proposed project and/or activity of exchanges and cooperation by appropriate means and in the proper scale of regulated possibilities. Simultaneously the BMC and the Stjordal Kommun pledge to encourage exchanges among public sector, educational institutes and private sector of the two cities, which would benefit both countries.
