

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
ON STRENGTHENING THE FRIENDLY COOPERATIVE RELATIONSHIP  
BETWEEN  
THE STANDING COMMITTEE OF THE BEIJING MUNICIPAL  
PEOPLE’S CONGRESS OF THE PEOPLE’S REPUBLIC OF CHINA  
AND  
THE BANGKOK METROPOLITAN COUNCIL  
OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND**

The Standing Committee of Beijing Municipal People’s Congress (BMPC) of the People’s Republic of China and the Bangkok Metropolitan Council (BMC) of the Kingdom of Thailand signed a Memorandum of Understanding for Friendly Exchange and Cooperation in 2001 to create friendly exchange and to promote better understanding and amity between BMPC and BMC. In 2025, both parties have come to an agreement to amend the Memorandum of Understanding signed in 2001 for the following purposes:

- Endeavoring to promote mutual understanding and interests in areas of Environment; Economy; Education; Traffic and Transportation; Drainage; Public Health; Urban Planning; Tourism, Sports and Culture; Local Administration and Orderliness; Community Development and Social Welfare and Digital Technology.

- Encouraging exchanges between both parties, especially the exchange of irregularly-scheduled official delegations to visit each city to strengthen the friendship and contact. While visiting each city, all expenses shall be borne by the visiting delegation. Appropriate courtesy reception will be arranged accordingly by the receiving party while the official delegation visits.

- Encouraging and supporting exchange between youth, public organizations and citizen groups or associations in the two cities on the principle of equality. Specific items of exchange and cooperation shall be discussed and confirmed directly by departments or individuals involved by appropriate means.

This MOU was signed in Beijing on 16 September 2025 and shall be effective on the date of its signature. It was done in triplicate in Chinese, Thai, and English languages, all texts being equally authentic. In case of divergence of interpretation, the English text shall prevail.
